TO HELP US REMEMBER: *Ephesians 5:19 "Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."*

**TEEN THOUGHT:** This chapter continues Chapter 4's discussion of how we can live as fragrant offerings to God, and on the other hand that immorality (sexual immorality, greed, obscenity, coarse joking, getting drunk – all things the world around us indulges in) can lead to losing our inheritance in the kingdom.
