


# Personal Responsibility

Its Not My Fault Because: The Devil Made Me Do It - Eve

Genesis 3:8-11

"Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma. But do not let immorality or any impurity or greed even be named among you, as is proper among saints; and there must be no filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.

#### Its Not My Fault Because: Someone Made Me Do It - Adam

Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. Therefore do not be partakers with them; for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light(for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth), trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. And do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them;"

### Its Not My Fault Because: God Made Me Do It - Adam

"...Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat? And the man said, "The woman whom Thou gavest to be with me, she gave me from the tree, and I ate."" *Gen. 3:11-12*
