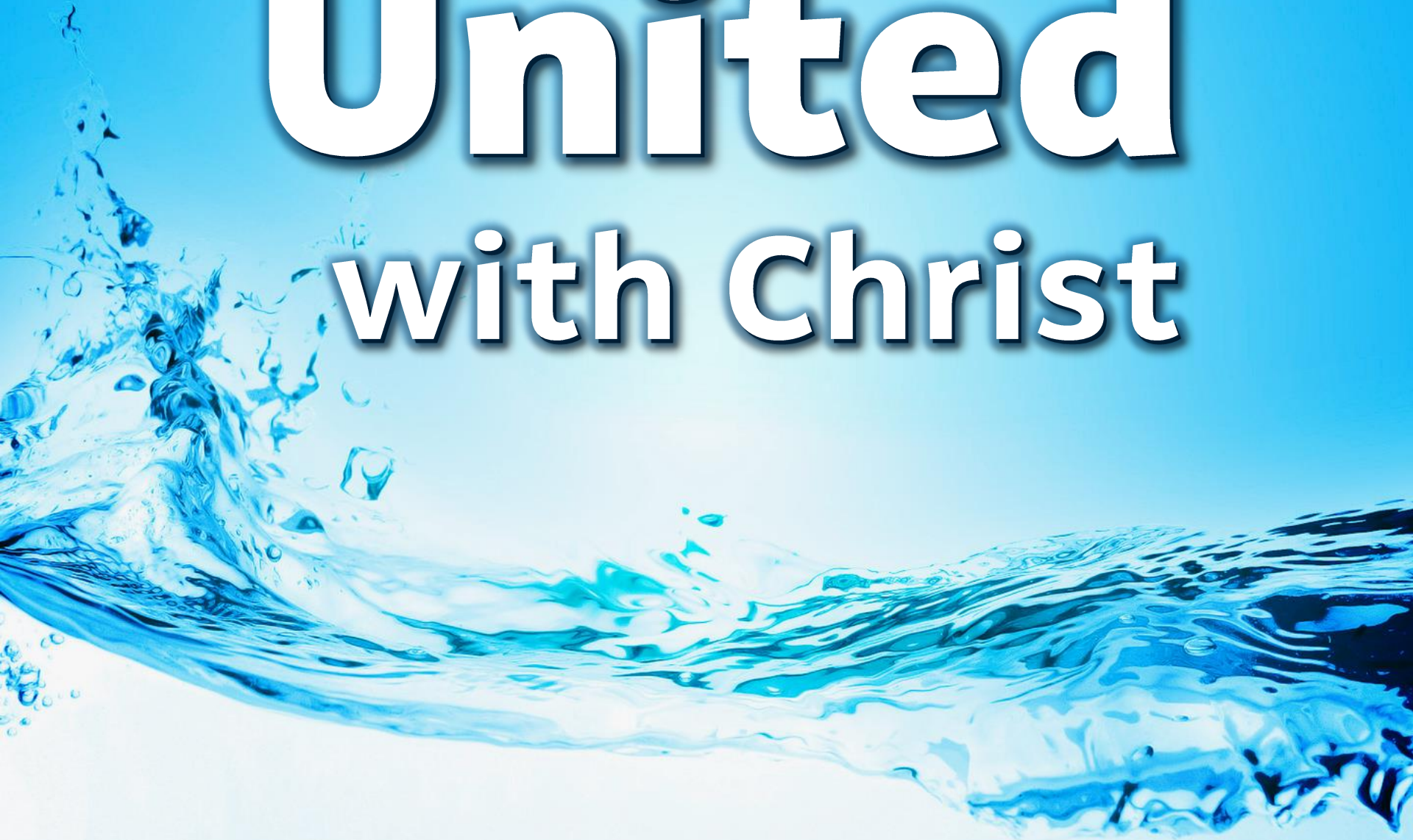

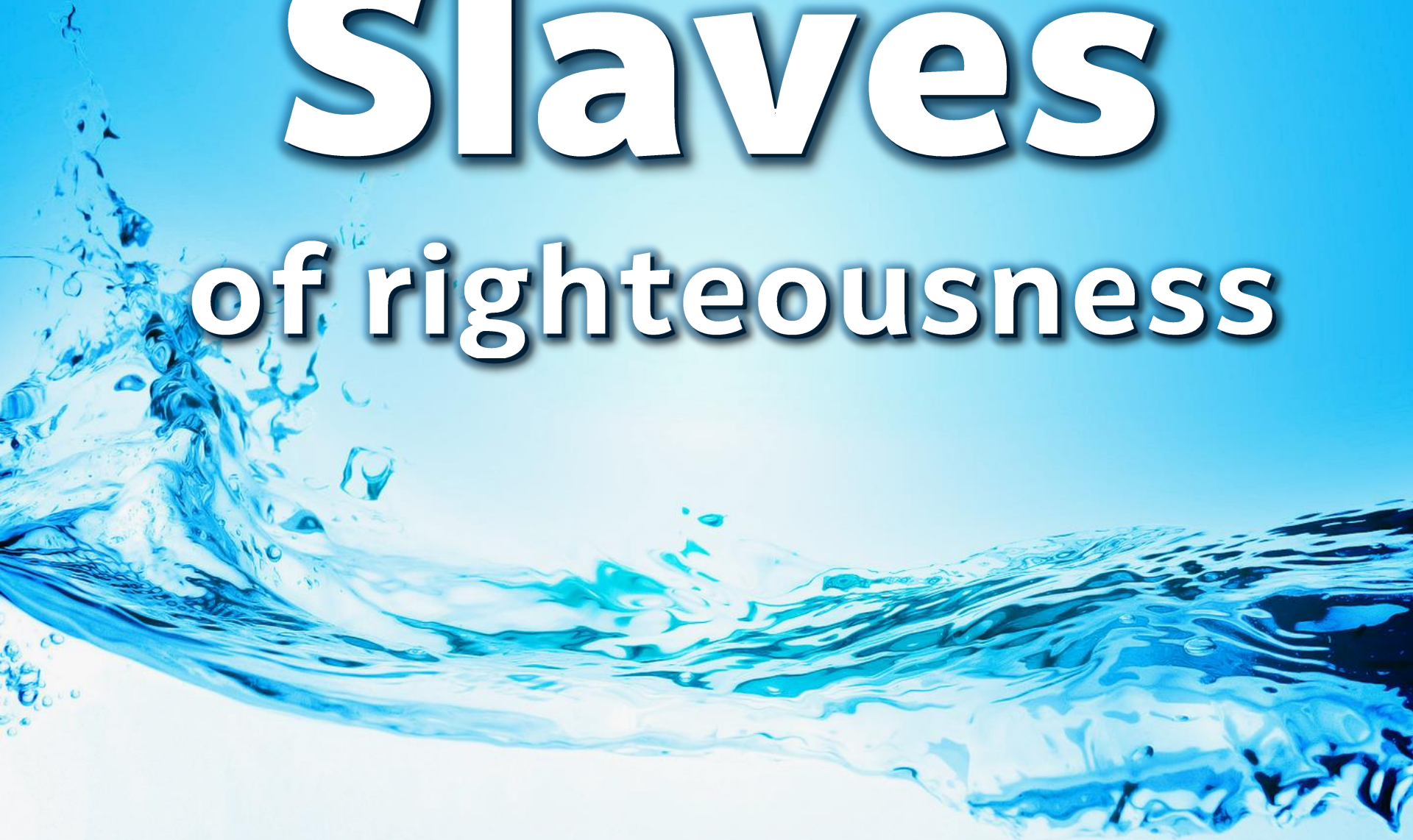
**Do not present your members
